Spelling Errors:

Error Type	Example of Error	Explanation of Error	Example of Correction
Simple Spelling Errors	<i>"The authors searched for relevant studeies using Google Scholar."</i>	"Studies" is spelt incorrectly.	<i>"The authors searched for relevant studies using Google Scholar."</i>
Space Missing Between Words	<i>"We measured the heart rateand blood pressure of each patient."</i>	No space between "rate" and "and".	<i>"We measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."</i>
Duplicated Words	<i>"We measured measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."</i>	"Measured" is repeated.	<i>"We measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."</i>

Grammatical Errors:

Error Type	Example of Error	Explanation of Error	Example of Correction
Missing Articles (a/an/the)	<i>"We measured heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."</i>	Missing article ("the") between "measured" and "heart".	<i>"We measured the heart rate and blood pressure of each patient."</i>
Misuse of Prepositions (e.g., in/at/on/of/for/to)	<i>"We believe this treatment plan is beneficial for the treatment of patients for hospital."</i>	Incorrect preposition used – should be "in" rather than "for".	<i>"We believe this treatment plan is beneficial for the treatment of patients in hospital."</i>
Subject-Verb Agreement (Singular vs Plural Subjects and Verbs)	<i>"We found five genes that is upregulated in cancer."</i>	Incorrect verb used – as the noun "gene" is plural ("genes"), the attached verb should also be plural ("are").	<i>"We found five genes that are upregulated in cancer."</i>
Verb Tenses (Incorrect Tense Used)	<i>"As our results shown, this treatment plan appears to be beneficial for the treatment of patients."</i>	The results are currently being presented, so present tense should be used in this sentence ("show").	<i>"As our results show, this treatment plan appears to be beneficial for the treatment of patients."</i>
Noun Number (Incorrect Use of Plurals)	<i>"We found five gene that are upregulated in cancer."</i>	As there is more than one gene (five), the noun "gene" should be plural ("genes"), not singular.	<i>"We found five genes that are upregulated in cancer."</i>

Missing Words:

Error Type	Example of Error	Explanation of Error	Example of Correction
Missing Words	<i>"Patients under the age of 18 excluded from the current study."</i>	The word "were" is missing from the sentence. Note that the word after the missing word will be highlighted in the MLA report.	<i>"Patients under the age of 18 were excluded from the current study."</i>
