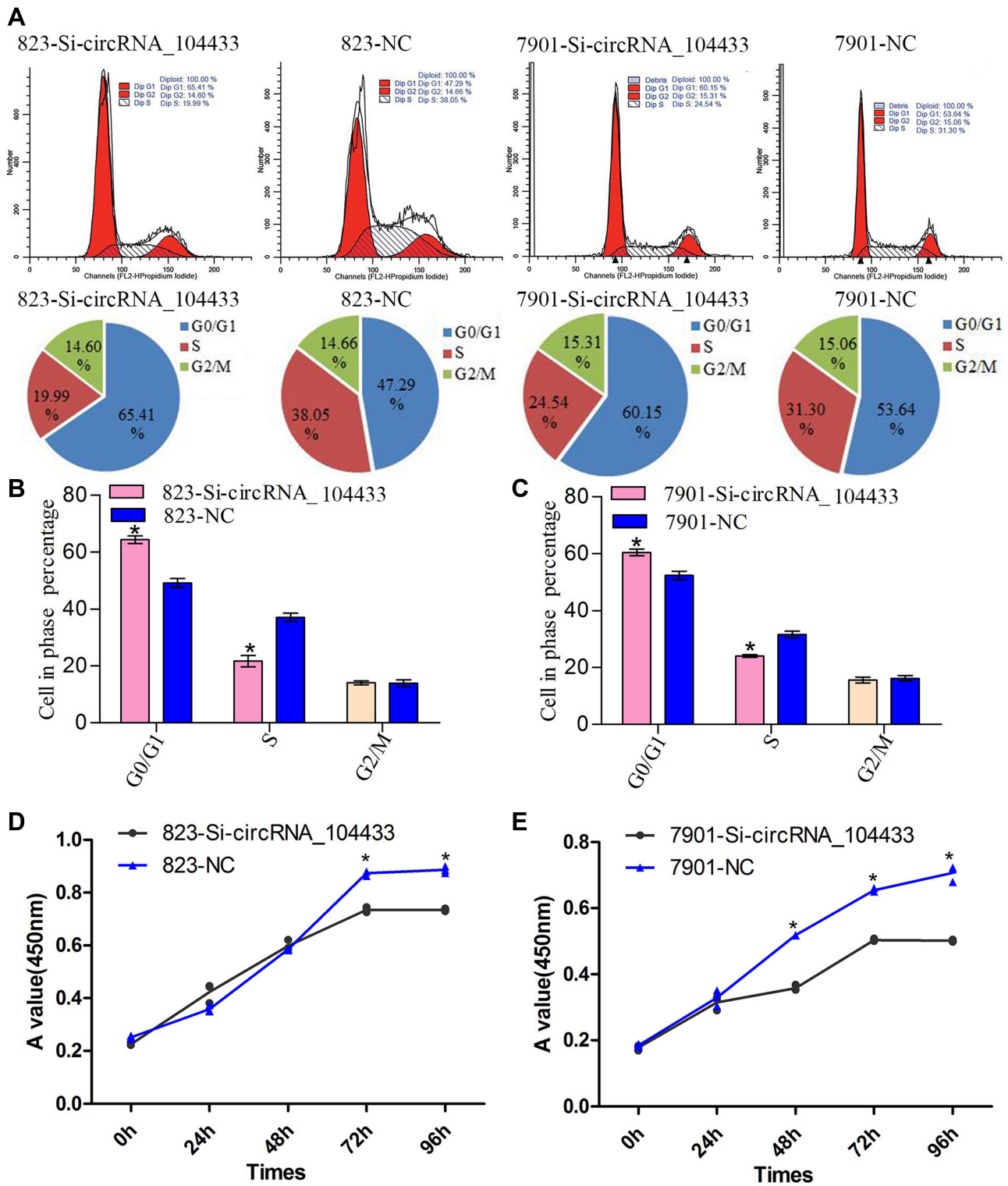


Figure 3 The effect of knockdown of circRNA_104433 on cell cycle distribution and proliferation in GC cells.

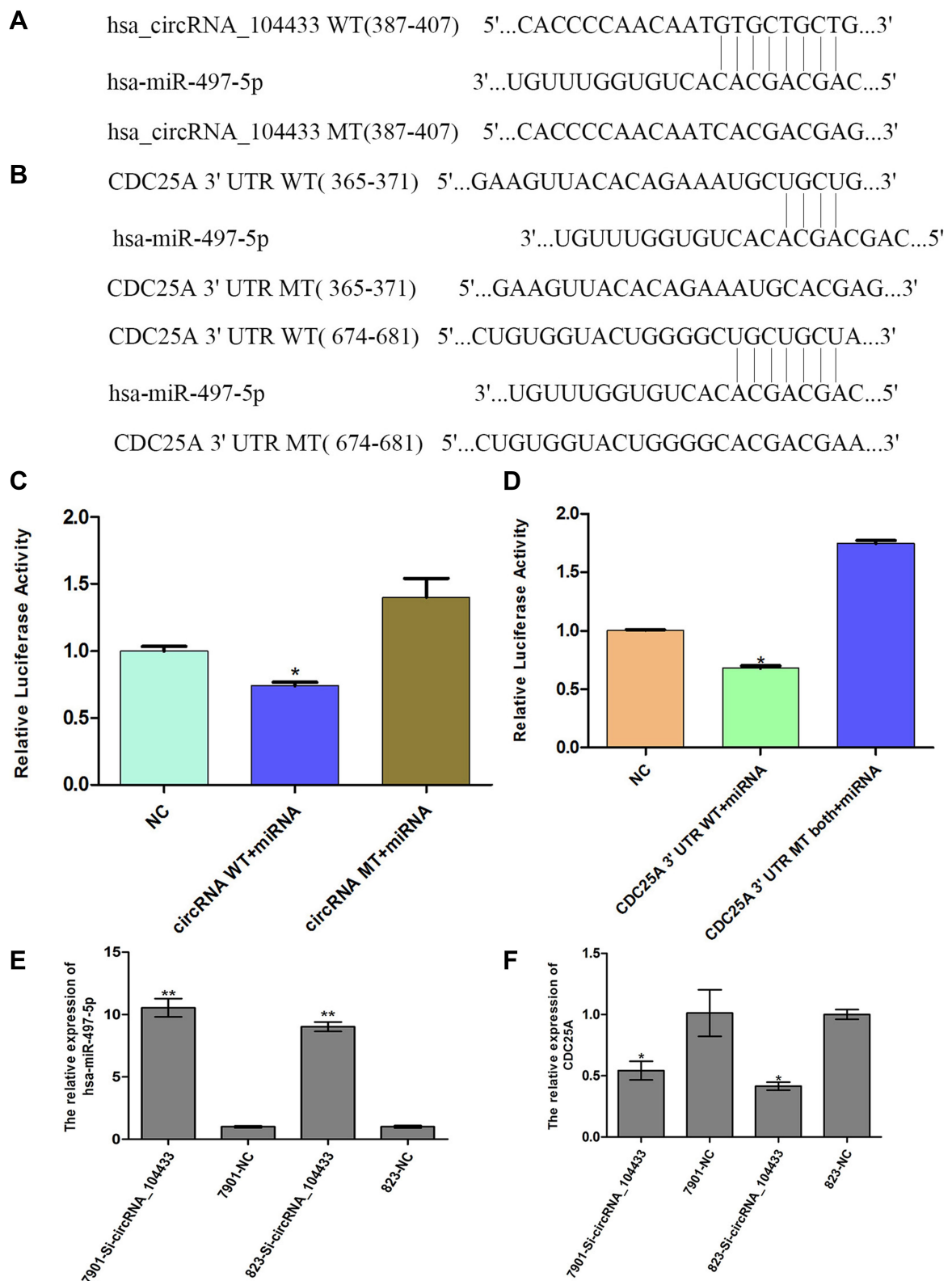


Figure 5 Confirmation of target gene.
